Conclusion

We can trace the Kelly paternal line back to John Kelly who was born in Ireland in 1811. We know from census records that John was born in Ireland but we do not know whereabouts. We can trace no death record for John, however there may be further evidence available from the Catholic Archives. This will give us a death date for John but it is highly unlikely that a place of birth other than Ireland will be mentioned in any other documents.

We can however go back one further generation along the Trainer line. We can see from the 1841 census that Thomas Trainer and Roseanne Trainer were both born in Ireland in the 1770s. Again we know that they were born in Ireland but where in Ireland still eludes us.

Census returns give us a lot of information regarding our ancestors. There has been a census since 1801 but it was only with the 1841 census and after that the details were kept. The 1841 census is scant on detail but more information was added as the each census passed.

I have tried to be as accurate as I can be, however due to the quality and age of the documents it is at times hard to decipher the information. Where I am unsure of what had been written I have let you know and have also let you know where I have made assumptions with regards to the evidence available to me.

I hope this research gives you a window into the past and has brought your ancestors closer to you.
